We continue to grow:

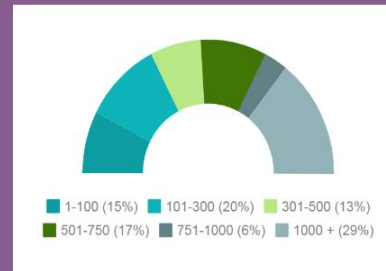
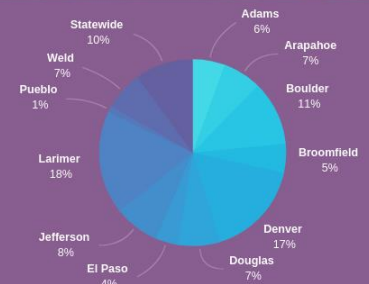
- DOVIA Colorado now has **495 volunteer professionals receiving education and support** compared to 44 members in 2014! That's 1,125% growth in 4 short years.

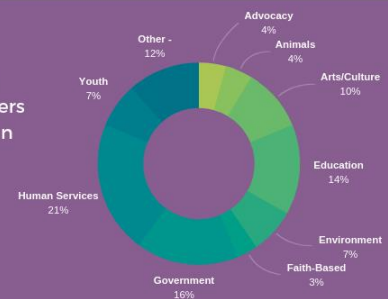
